and dangerous, according to the Sheriff's Office.

The search for Carter stems from an incident that occurred the evening of

Saturday, Sept. 8, according to the Sheriff's Office.

Deputies responded to Chatuge Regional Hospital in reference to a male subject who

was brought to the hospital with a bullet wound to the chest, according to the Sheriff's Office.

The victim was identified as William Craig Henderson of Young Harris, and he was airlifted to another medical facility with a trauma center, where he remains in stable condition, according to the Sheriff's Office.

After dropping Henderson of at Chatuge Regional Hospital, Carter left in his Chevrolet Tahoe, according to the Sheriff's Office.

The vehicle was discovered later that night, abandoned in the parking lot of the Marathon station on Georgia 75 North in Hiawassee, according to the Sheriff's Office.

Detectives determined that Carter left the Marathon station in a red Ford pickup belonging to her, according to the Sheriff's Office.

Her truck was located at a residence in Clay County, North Carolina, on Sunday afternoon, and investigators believe Carter is somewhere in the area of Hiawassee and Hayesville, North Carolina.
